VOTING ABSENTEE IS AS EASY AS 1, 2, 3.

- 1. REQUEST** your ballot – the sooner the better to assist in managing the volume.
- 2. AWAIT** your ballots arrival (no sooner than 45 days prior to the election)
- 3. VOTE & RETURN** your ballot to the Clerk no later than closing of the polls on election day.
