LEGAL NOTICE NOTICE OF ELECTION ON THE ORGANIZATION OF THE UPPER BIG LOST RIVER GROUND WATER DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: Pursuant to Idaho Code, Chapter 52, Title 42, the Board of Commissioners for Custer County have ordered that an election shall be held on November 4, 2025, for the purpose of determining whether the Upper Big Lost River Ground Water District (the "District") shall be organized and, if so, who shall be its initial directors. The following polling places shall be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on November 4, 2025, for the purpose of voting:

Mackay Fire Hall 105 Cedar Ave Mackay, IDAHO 83251

Electors shall be required to cast ballots containing the words, "Ground Water District --- Yes," or "Ground Water District --- No," and to cast ballots for each of the directors of the District. All ground water irrigators, as defined by statute, within the proposed District's boundaries may vote at the election. As provided by statute, holders of ground water rights for commercial, municipal or in-dustrial purposes within the proposed District's boundaries may participate in the election only by providing the judges of election notice in writing at least ten (10) working days prior to the election.

All ground water irrigators within the boundaries of the District will become members of the District and subject to its assessments if the District is formed. Holders of commercial, municipal or industrial ground water rights may become members if they participated in the election by providing ten (10) working days notice or by providing notice in accordance with statutory requirements within sixty (60) days after the date on which the District is formed.
