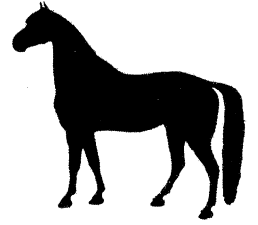

Lead Line

13. For riders too young to show a horse on their own.

Lead line riders must be led by someone who is experienced enough to handle a horse and a young rider in the arena with other horses and young riders.

Note: Late registration will be charged a \$10 fee.

Participants must wear long pants and boots. Helmets are encouraged. Event organizers have the right to ask any participant to leave the arena if they are unable to control their animal and/or present a safety concern.

Points will be calculated by placing:

- 1st - 5pts
- 2nd - 4pts
- 3rd - 3pts
- 4th - 2pts
- 5th - 1pt

The highest point contestant in each age group will win the champion belt buckle.
