## Absentee Voting

The Clerk's Office will do In-Person Absentee Voting at the Courthouse starting in October.

You can request an absentee ballot by mail for the General Election!

- Return this **\*[2024 Absentee Ballot Request Form](#)\*** to our office
- Or, currently registered voters can go online to [voteidaho.gov](https://VoteIdaho.gov) and request their absentee ballot

The deadline to request and absentee ballot by mail for the General Election is October 25, 2024

Absentee ballots need to be returned to the Courthouse (in person or by mail) by 8 pm on Election Day, do not deliver them directly to a precinct.

## Polling Locations

If you have been voting at the Legion Hall in the past, you will now vote at the Challis Community Center at 411 Clinic Road. All other polling places remain the same:

## Proof of Identification Requirements for Voting

**VOTE IDAHO**  
**Required ID**  
**for Voter Check-in**

All voters must provide one of the following photo IDs to receive a ballot:

- ✓ A Current Idaho Driver's License or Identification Card
- ✓ A Current U.S. Passport or Federal Photo Identification Card
- ✓ A Current Tribal Photo Identification Card
- ✓ A Current Concealed Weapons License

If you are a registered voter with no outstanding requirements and do not have one of the above photo IDs, you may sign a **Personal Identification Affidavit**.

## Voter Registration

Register anytime through October 11<sup>th</sup> at the Courthouse or at [Registering To Vote | VoteIdaho.Gov](https://www.voteidaho.gov)  
 Register and vote at the same time in the Courthouse from October 13<sup>th</sup> – November 1st  
 Register to vote at your precinct on Election Day

*Note: If you move within the county you have to re-register!*

### Proof of Identification and Residency Requirements for Registration

#### Photo ID

- Current Idaho Driver's License or Identification Card
- Current U.S. Passport or Federal Identification Card
- Current Tribal Identification Card
- Current Concealed Weapons License

#### Proof of Residence

- Any of the above photo IDs with correct residence address
- Current proof of insurance
- Deed of trust, mortgage, lease or rental agreement
- A property tax assessment, bill, or receipt
- A utility bill, excluding a cellular telephone bill
- A bank or credit card statement
- A paystub, paycheck, or government-issued check
- An intake document from a residential care or assisted living facility
- Enrollment papers issued for the current school year by a high school, or an accredited institution of higher education located within the state of Idaho.
- A communication on letterhead from a public or private social service agency registered with the secretary of state verifying the applicant is homeless and attesting to the applicant's residence for registration purposes.
