Absentee Voting

You can now request an absentee ballot(s) for this year!

- Currently registered voters can go online to voteidaho.gov and request their absentee ballot
- Or return this [*2024 Absentee Ballot Request Form*](#) to our office

The deadline to request and absentee ballot by mail for the General Election is October 25, 2024

Absentee ballots need to be returned to the Courthouse (in person or by mail), do not deliver them directly to a precinct

The Clerk's Office will do In-Person Absentee Voting at the Courthouse starting in October.

Voter Registration

Register anytime through October 11th at the Courthouse or at [Registering To Vote | VoteIdaho.Gov](#)

Register and vote at the same time in the Courthouse from October 13th – November 1st

Register to vote at your precinct on Election day

Note: If you move within the county you have to re-register!

State of Idaho Identification

Whether you are a new voter or a current voter, a current Idaho Driver License (or other approved forms of Identification) will be more important than ever in 2024! (And it's the [Law](#))

Driver licenses services are found at The Custer County Sheriff's Office (behind the courthouse across the parking lot). They are open Monday – Friday 8 am – 4:30 pm (208) 879-2232

NEW Proof of Identification Requirements for Voting

VOTE IDAHO
Required ID
for Voter Check-in

All voters must provide one of the following photo IDs to receive a ballot:

- ✓ A Current Idaho Driver's License or Identification Card
- ✓ A Current U.S. Passport or Federal Photo Identification Card
- ✓ A Current Tribal Photo Identification Card
- ✓ A Current Concealed Weapons License

If you are a registered voter with no outstanding requirements and do not have one of the above photo IDs, you may sign a **Personal Identification Affidavit**.

Affiliation

Affiliation only affects ballot choice options in Primary Elections, affiliation does not impact ballot choices in the General Election this November.
