Testimony: There was none.


Deliberation ensued between the Board of County Commissioners.


The Board members all agreed that improper disposal of used oil or chemicals within the solid waste program was causing unnecessary problems. The establishment of separation requirements, civil penalties and incorporating applicable Idaho Code and Idaho Dept. of Environmental Quality standards will help mitigate this problem.

Commissioner Will Naillon then made a motion to approve Ordinance #01-2026 Regulating the disposal of used oil and chemicals in solid waste. Providing for separation requirements, establishing civil penalties, and incorporating applicable Idaho Code and Idaho Dept. of Environmental Quality standards.

Commissioner Gordon Vaden seconded the motion. There was no further discussion and the roll call vote was Corgatelli/Aye, Vaden/Aye and Naillon/Aye. The motion passed.

Chairman Randy Corgatelli then concluded the Public Hearing process and the meeting was adjourned at 5:07 P.M.
